 DATE *Farmers* BOUGHT OF *Fruit* No. *Cake* No. *12*
 Soak three cups of dried apples
 over night in warm water,
 chop slightly in the morning,
 then simmer two hours or more
 in two cups of molasses,
 until the apples resemble citron
 make a cake of two eggs, one cup
 sugar, one cup sweet milk
 1/2 cup butter, 1/2 teaspoonful
 soda, flour to make a rather
 thick batter, spices in plenty,
 put in the apples and bake slow
 in large dripping pan
