DEATHS

West Hartford, Conn. - **MORRIS "SANDY" SANDERS**, 78, a resident of Whiting and a resident of West Hartford, Conn. since October, died Wednesday, January 14, 2004, at the John Dempsey Hospital in Farmington, Conn. He was born December 31, 1925, in Rochester, the son of Pearle George and Lucy (Hook) Sanders.

Mr. Sanders attended Rochester schools. He enlisted in the U.S. Navy serving during WWII and Korea. He spent four years on the Destroyer Lyman K. Swenson. Mr. Sanders married Rita Jay on April 22, 1955.

He was employed by the state of Vermont, retiring in 1989 following 10 years of service. Following his retirement, he worked during the summers at Button Bay State Park, DAR Park, and most recently several seasons as a security guard at the Shelburne Museum.

Mr. Sanders was a lifelong member of the Veterans of Foreign Wars where he held several and local offices, a member of the American Legion Post 50 in Castleton and an honorary member of the Whiting Volunteer Fire Department.

He held several offices for the town of Whiting including Selectman, Assistant Town Clerk of the Peace, Town Hall Caretaker and Forest Fire Warden.

Mr. Sanders was well known as "the guy to go to, to get things done" in Whiting and it has been said that he could sell a raffle ticket to a lamppost.

He volunteered for many years as an umpire for area schools.

Survivors include his wife, Rita of West Hartford, Conn.; two daughters, Marren Sanders of Franklin, Mass., and Jane Yousman and her husband Bill of West Hartford, Conn.; two sisters, Joyce Rhodes of Bethel and Lila Jay of East Poultney; three grandchildren, Rachel Yousman, Nathan Yousman and Kayla Yousman; several nieces, nephews, sisters-in law and brothers-in-law.

He was predeceased by his parents; two sisters, Marie Andres and Marion Daniels; four brothers, Roland Sanders, George Sanders, Oris Sanders and Otis Sanders.

Friends may call from 2-5 p.m. Sunday at the Miller and Ketcham Funeral Home.

Funeral services will be held 10 a.m. Monday at the funeral home. Following the service, friends and family are invited to the Middlebury VFW for a luncheon.

Burial will be at a later date at the Vermont Veterans Memorial Cemetery in Randolph.

He was a 32nd degree Mason and an active member of the Masonic fraternity, holding memberships in Bible Lodge 27 in Goffstown, N.H., the Scottish Rite, Bektash Shrine in N.H., Martha Washington Chapter 6, Order of the Eastern Star in Goffstown.

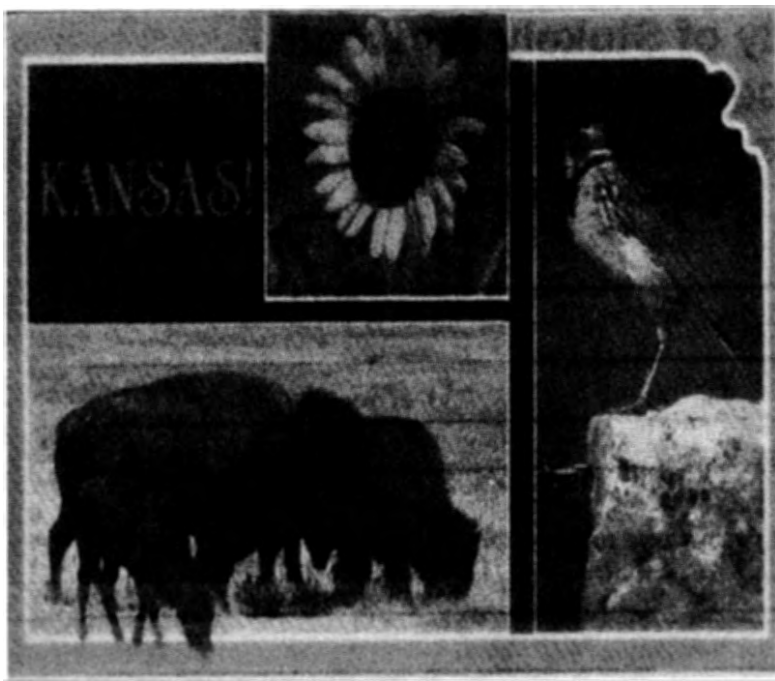

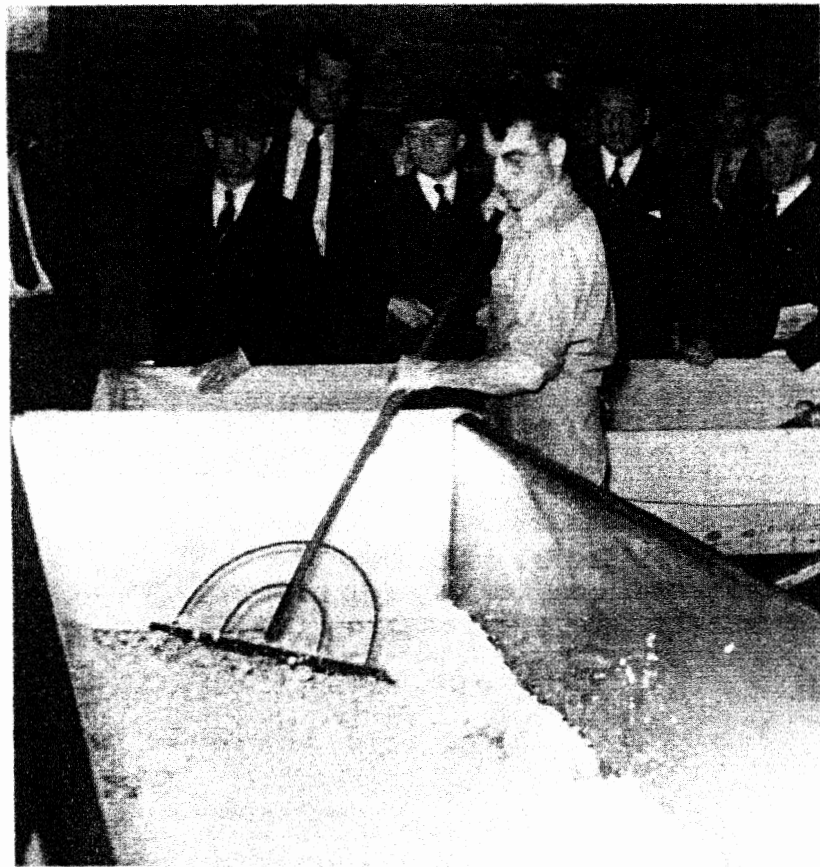

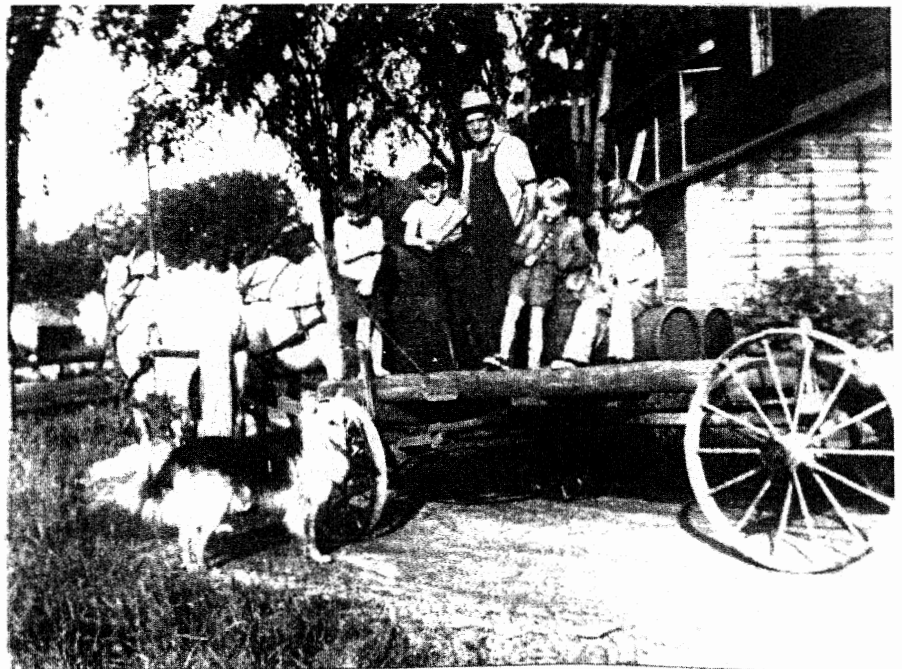
